

Annual Wine Challenge 2013 Results Brief

Commentary

The 2013 Wine Challenge was held at Brightwell Vineyard on Saturday 15th June 2013. 28 wines from 8 vineyards were entered from the Region – slightly lower than last year, but this was quite understandable considering the poor harvest in 2012 suffered by many vineyards. The four judges led by Patricia Stefanowicz MW commented that the quality of the wines overall was very good. The Rose class proved to be popular for a 3rd year running with 6 entries, and therefore justified the award of our newest trophy – the Stefanowicz salver, kindly donated by Patricia Stefanowicz. For the first time, the Best Wine Overall Trophy was awarded to a Rose wine.
