

Annual Wine Challenge 2014 Results Brief

Commentary

The 2014 Wine Challenge was held at Marlow Winery on Sunday September 14th 2014. 44 wines from 13 vineyards were entered from the Region – our best ever turnout both in numbers of wines and vineyards – this reflects that some of the newly planted vineyards in the region started producing for the first time this year. The four judges led by Patricia Stefanowicz MW commented that the quality of the wines overall was very good. The numbers of wines entered per class were as follows:

Class 1: Dry White, 2013 – 17 entries; Class 2: Dry White, prior to 2013- 8 entries; Class 3: White, not dry, any year – 2 entries;

Class 4: Red, any year – 4 entries; Class 5: Rose, any year – 7 entries; Class 6: Sparkling, any year, any colour – 6 entries.
