

Annual Wine Challenge 2018 Results Brief

Commentary

The 2018 Wine Challenge was held at Winding Wood Vineyard on Sunday September 2nd 2018. 32 wines from 12 vineyards were entered from the Region. The four judges led by Patricia Stefanowicz MW commented that the quality of the wines this year was exceptionally good, as can be seen by the number of Gold medals awarded, especially in the sparkling wine class. The numbers of wines entered per class were as follows: **Class 1:** Dry White, 2017 – 7 entries; **Class 2:** Dry White, prior to 2016- 5 entries; **Class 3:** White, not dry, any year – 0 entries; **Class 4:** Red, any year – 1 entry; **Class 5:** Rose, any year – 3 entries; **Class 6:** Sparkling, any year, any colour – 16 entries.
