

Annual Wine Challenge 2021 Results Brief

Commentary

The 2021 Wine Challenge was held at Oaken Grove Vineyard on Sunday September 5th 2021. 27 wines from 9 vineyards were entered from the Region. Exceptionally, no wines from the 2020 vintage were entered, since most vineyards lost their crop to frost last year. The five judges led by Patricia Stefanowicz MW commented that despite the low number of entries, the quality of the wines was exceptionally good, reflected in 4 Gold medals, and that the older wines had held their quality well.

Class 1: Dry White, 2020 – none; Class 2: Dry White, prior to 2020 - 8 entries; Class 3: White, not dry, any year – none;

Class 4: Red, any year – 2 entries; Class 5: Rose, any year – 4 entries; Class 6: Sparkling, any year, any colour – 13 entries (10 white, 3 Rosé).
