2. Minutes and Actions from 2014 AGM

The minutes were approved, and all actions completed. It was noted that the TCVA objection to the funding of the International Cool Climate Wine Symposium 2016 led to conditions being applied to the £10k contribution from the UKVA.

3. Chairman's Report (Bob Nielsen)

Thanks were given to Denise Santilli for her work as Secretary to the T&CVA.

Role of The T&CVA: the UKVA is made up of 7 regional associations of which we are one. Prior to the internet, the role of regional associations was to help to train members, network and conduct activities on a local level. With the advent of the internet, the need for local activities has reduced since so much training etc. is provided on a national level by the UKVA. What the T&CVA can still provide is representation on a national level. We are no longer the smallest regional association and the T&CVA is a vehicle to be used as we want it to be. We adopt a "pay as you go" basis to keep regional subs affordable and the principals of the T&CVA honest. We front load our costs and recoup them back as we go along. We do not pay our Officers or Committee members. Bob, as our Chairman, represents us at UKVA council.

Engagement with the UKVA: Bob is Council member of the UKVA. At the June 2014 meeting to further the discussion of a Vision and Strategy for the UKVA, it was decided not to employ consultants to tell us what we already know. Instead working groups were set up comprising UKVA members who come with a variety of skills. The 3 working groups which cover Governance & Structure, Marketing & Promotion, and Information & Training, have been ongoing and we should expect to hear the outcomes shortly. Bob is not a member of these workshops but he is invited to provide constructive criticism of their outcomes (and frequently does!). The next council meeting is in late May.

<u>UKVA & EWP:</u> these two bodies are closely affiliated, but separate. The EWP is a Marketing and Promotional body funded by the larger vineyards and enables us to "punch above our weight" on an international level. The trickle-down effect on smaller vineyards is positive as shown by the increased awareness and prestige associated with English wine (as shown by the recent England vs New Zealand wine competition where England were very successful winners). Whether the UKVA and EWP merge or not will be seen in the outcome of the Marketing and Promotion working group. Prowein and the International Wine Fair are two examples of international promotion of English Wine.

<u>ICCWS</u>: This is an academic symposium funded by a private funding initiative with £10k support from the UKVA. It is taking place in Brighton in 2016 so expect lots of communications about this event in the coming months. If the total funding required is not reached by the Private Funding Initiative, we can expect the UKVA to be approached for a further contribution – which of course will come from our membership fees. Bob will ensure that the T&CVA are informed if this is the case so that we can object or accept this situation.

<u>Conclusion:</u> English Wine is now a real success – our only problem now (a nice one to have!) is meeting demand. The key to this success is to continue producing high quality wines that can command a high price to cover our high production costs and making this a profitable business.

The TCVA financial year has been changed so that it aligns with the UKVA financial year, so these accounts are for 15 months only and the full year accounts will be sent to everyone in Sept 2015. The T&CVA members have had 6 months free membership of UKVA due to this change.

UKVA affiliation fees for 2015/16 are payable from 1st August 2015. Individual member's fees will be **£40**; Vineyard levy per tenth Ha **£7.15**.

The Wine Festival in 2014 made a loss of £100 due to fewer people than anticipated attending (probably due to location and bad weather). It provided good publicity nevertheless. The majority of costs in the trophies / certificates section was due to backengraving of trophies.

The debtors figure of £585.48 was due to a large subscription fee not having been paid when the accounts were prepared. This however had been paid prior to the AGM.

Our net current assets were £2068.40

It was proposed by Bob Nielsen and seconded by Patricia Stefanowicz that the accounts be adopted. This was passed unanimously.
